
From the Movie Committee

"Watch Parties" Keep Patrons Connected and Elicit Donations During Pandemic

On March 7th, after hosting 139 people at our screening of King Kong, the movie committee was riding high. We had just come off a highly successful February where we saw nearly two hundred people attend the silent film *The Man Who Laughs* introducing many new people to our theater and organ. It seemed like we were well on our way to a highly profitable year, and we were excited for the upcoming schedule. Then Covid-19 hit, and all our plans came crashing down. On March 16, the governor ordered that gatherings be limited to 50 people, prompting the cancellation of our upcoming screening of Metropolis on March 21. As we tried to figure out what that might mean for our beloved theater going forward, one thing was clear: we had no idea how long it would be until we could reopen. There was no telling how long we would have to wait before we could see the friendly faces of our patrons or hear the nostalgic



strains of melody from our Mighty Wurlitzer wafting through the theater as we popped popcorn, chatted with friends, or prepared the projector room before showtime.



While we were all happy to do our part to stop the spread of this potentially deadly disease, we also knew that we could not just sit idly by. We had to do something, and within the first week of the shutdown, Nick Baldwin, (a movie fanatic, DTOS member, and digital native) came up with an idea. Just because we were all stuck inside our houses did not mean we could not continue to entertain our audience. Our movie program may have seemed broken, but we could rebuild it, we have the technology. It seemed that everyone, from local musicians to Hollywood movie stars, were taking to social media platforms to perform or just to reach out to their fans and followers as more and more people across the nation were



going on lockdown. And so, on March 21st, The Senate Watch Party was born, and we have been screening a wide variety of films every Saturday night at 8:00 pm ever since.
