Work to be done. (Lance Luce)

I hope this finds everyone healthy during the pandemic. I hope you are staying safe while still enjoying the summer weather. As with most everything, our schedule came to an abrupt halt in March of 2020, and we are still not certain when things will return to normal. We intend to open the theater again as soon as theaters can do so. We have got 3 organists waiting in the wings for this Fall/Winter, so keep your fingers crossed. In the meantime, we have a few tasks at hand. One is putting the finishing

touches on the new marquee. The LED displays are done and running, and there are now 134 white bulbs on the underside of the sign that light at night, as well as 8 new blue neon stars, 4 on each end. There is some metal trim work that needs to be completed to cover up the old brick on each side of the front, from the sign down to the sidewalk. That metal work is going to be \$6,000. The other task that needs doing is re-leathering one of the regulators on the organ. This regulator is in the orchestral chamber and supplies the air to the Brass Saxophone, Quintadena, Quintadena Celeste, Orchestral Oboe and Cor Anglais ranks. A temporary patch has been put on the deteriorated leather, but it needs to be taken out and done completely. Scott Smith and associates will do this work for \$2,500 and will donate their time and mileage for the removal and reinstallation, which

is generous of them.

We are asking for donations to help cover these costs, especially at this time while we have had no income. If you could help us defer these expenses, we would greatly appreciate it!
